Discerning buyers will immediately take note of the cosmetic condition. In the fall of 2015, the aircraft was completely stripped and tastefully repainted white with medium grey and red accents. Concurrent with the paint, interior hard and soft goods were refurbished and feature the desirable eight (8) passenger configuration with an aft belted lavatory. All five (5) executive club chairs are completed in cream colored leather, and the aft two (2) place side-facing divan is finished in complementary chocolate leather. Serial Number 255 features a spacious forward refreshment center in a satin wood finish, with cabin entertainment provided by dual (2) DVD players, dual (2) Bulkhead monitors, a 10-disc CD player, and Airshow 400.
